

Alphabet business card holder



Hoop your stabilizer I used 2.5 oz cut away starting with the pocket run your placement stitches. Remove from machine and lay down the top fabric. (Unless you want to a bottom fabric is not needed.) Return to the machine and run the tack down stitches then remove from machine and trim the fabric. Return to machine and finish. You need 2 pockets. Repeat these instructions with your alphabet square.

Front:

Hoop your stabilizer and run the placement stitches. Lay down your main fabric and then run the tack down stitches and then the placement stitches for your alphabet square. Place your alphabet square down on the placement stitches (here I use scotch tape to hold in place) run the tack down stitches and the satin stitches on the alphabet square. Remove from machine and add your back fabric. Return and run the tack down stitches. Trim the back and front fabric and place one of the pockets on the back again taping in place or pin the center. Run the tack down and satin stitches.



Back:

Hoop your stabilizer and run the placement stitches lay down your back and front fabric and run the tack down trim the fabric and then place the pocket and run the tack down and satin stitches.

To complete I used a zigzag stitch on my regular sewing machine.
