

# Alphabet Notebook Cover



## Alphabet Square

Stitch the alphabet square and the pockets first.

Hoop the stabilizer I used

2.5oz cutaway. Run the placement stitches and then lay down the fabric run the tack down stitches and then the letter. Trim excess fabric and then finish the square. Repeat on the pockets ( I did not use a back fabric on the pockets)

## Center

Hoop the stabilizer and run the placement stitches. Lay your top and bottom fabric down and run the tack down stitches trim front and back fabric and finish the panel

## Front

Hoop the stabilizer and run the placement stitches. Lay down the top fabric and then run the tack down stitches. Next will run the placement for the alphabet square I taped the square in place using scotch tape run the tack down stitches and the satin stitches.

Now lay down the back fabric and run the tack down stitches. Trim the front and back fabric and then lay down one of the pocket pieces I again taped to hold run the tack down stitches and the satin stitches.

## Back

Hoop your stabilizer then run the placement stitches lay down your front and back fabric and run the tackdown stitches. Trim the fabric then lay down the pocket piece and tape to hold in place.

Run the tack down stitches and the satin stitches. To assemble stitch the front to the center piece and back to the opposite side of the center piece.
