

Ballet Purse

All Panels

Hoop your stabilizer

I used 2.5oz cut away

run your placement stitches.

Lay down your front and back

fabric, run your tack down stitches

then trim the front and back

fabric. Run all panels this way

To Assemble:

Stitch your front pieces together
as shown now add the tutu top.

I hand stitched the neck and
shoulders to the curve of the purse

and for now left the bottom of the

tutu free. Now take a piece of tulle

about 12 to 14 inches long and 2 to

2 ½ inches wide. Fold in ½ to make

the length about 6 to 8 inches long

then fold in ½ again to make about

1 to 1 ¼ inches wide. With needle

and thread run a stitch to gather the

tulle. Now attach to the purse just a

little above where the end of the

tutu top will cover the edge of the tulle.

Once secure place the top over and secure

it over the tulle and to the purse. Stitch the

bottom pieces together. Then to the bottom

of the purse front. Stitch the back together

then attach to the bottom pieces. Now

stitch the side to the bottom pieces, then

working from the bottom to top stitch the

sides to the front and back of purse, Both

sides.

For Handles I cut 2 fabric strips 1 ½ inch

wide and turned the right side in and ran

a machine straight stitch the full length.

Turned the tube right side out and attached

in the center of the 2 side pieces then tied

in a bow .

Separate the layers of tulle to puff the skirt and

trim near the bottom if you need to.

Embellish anyway you want with bows or rhinestones
