

Cat Door Hanger



Welcome sign

Hoop your stabilizer, I used 2oz cutaway. Run the placement stitches then remove from machine keeping hooped and lay down your chosen fabric for the front. Return to machine and run the tack down stitches and the words.

Remove from machine and lay down your chosen back fabric. Return to machine and run the tack down stitches once they are done remove from machine and trim the front and back fabric. Return to machine and run the final satin stitches.

Hoop your stabilizer, I use

2 oz. Cutaway. Stitch the lay down stitches on the sign then lay down your fabric and allow it to tack it down.

Next the head will stitch the placement stitches from there lay down the scrap of fabric you have chosen for the head. Next the paws will stitch the placement stitches from there lay down the fabric you have chosen for the paws.

The tail placement will stitch next, from there lay down the fabric you have chosen for it and tack it down.

Trim the excess fabric once all are tacked down and run the detail stitches such as the cat face and wording.

Once the wording is done stitching the back fabric placement stitches will stitch. Lay your back fabric down and run the tack down stitches then trim the back and return to the machine for the finish satin stitches.

Hot glue Ribbon to the back to create your hanger.
