

Doll Hair instructions



Draw a pencil line on the back of the dolls head to indicate where you hair line will end on this line using a doll needle start your hair. I ran a stitch into the dolls head then formed a loop in the yarn the length that I wanted her hair to be, next take a small stitch right next to your loop to hold the loop now proceed across your pencil line. Loop small stitch loop small stitch. when you get to the seam turn and go the opposite direction following the same stitch pattern (loop, small stitch, loop) once you get to the top of the head use smaller loops to form your bangs if you want your doll to have them. Once finished tie a knot and leave a tail about the length of your longest loop. you can leave it here or do more if you desire.

Starting at the back with my first loops I cut the loops at the center of the loop then tied in a square not to ensure that the yarn does not pull out. I work my way up the head until all loops are cut then I go back to the bottom at the back of the head and separate each yarn strand to fuss the yarn Work my way again to the top of the head once the yarn is fussy I then trim the yarn a bit into the style I want for my doll.
