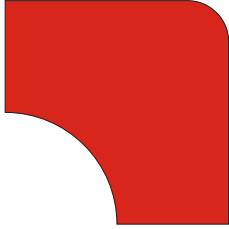


# Hot pad Instructions



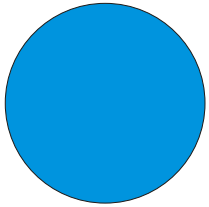
## Corner.

Hoop your stabilizer and run the straight stitches to indicate where your fabric goes.

Remove hoop from machine and place your fabric on the back side of the hoop and 1 layer of bonded batting then top with another scrap of fabric. Tape or spray to hold.

Return to the machine and run the rest of the straight stitches to tack down. Remove from machine keep hooped. Trim the excess fabric.

Return to the machine and run the satin stitches. You will need 4 of the corners.



## Center

Hoop your stabilizer and run the straight stitches to indicate where your fabric goes.

Remove hoop from machine and place 1 layer of bonded batting then top with another scrap of fabric. Tape or spray to hold.

Return to the machine and run the rest of the straight stitches to tack down. Run the center design and one more set of straight stitches

Remove from machine keep hooped add to the back of your hoop another scrap of fabric. Return to machine and run the rest of the straight stitches.

Remove hoop from machine but keep hooped, trim the excess fabric.

Return to the machine and run the satin stitches. You will need 1 center.

Sew the 4 corners together first.

Then sew in the center piece easing it in as you go.
