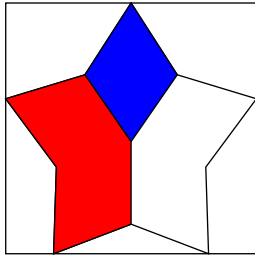


# July Table runner



## Star 2 block:

Hoop your stabilizer and run the placement stitches. Lay down your first fabric for the square. Run the tack down stitches. Now run the placement stitches for the star pieces. First the blue section then the white section then the red. Lay down the blue section fabric and run the tack down stitches trim fabric then lay down the white section and run the tack down stitches then trim now the red run tack down then trim. Run the satin stitches on the star. Lay down your back fabric and run the tack down stitches then trim back and front fabric then run to the end of the design.

## Star 1 Block & Napkin Holder front and back:

Hoop your stabilizer. I used 2.5oz cutaway. Run your background fabric placement stitches. Lay down the fabric and run the tack down stitches. Now run the placement stitches for the star. Top white section first working clockwise. Lay down the white fabric and run tack down stitches trim fabric and lay down your first red fabric. tack down and trim fabric lay down your next red fabric run the tack down and trim fabric run the last 2 the same way. run the satin stitches on the star. Lay down your back fabric and run the tack down stitches trim front and back then finish with the satin stitches.

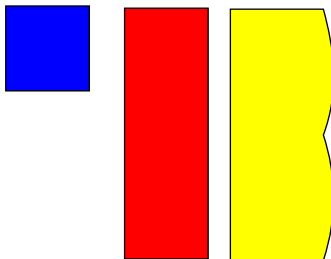
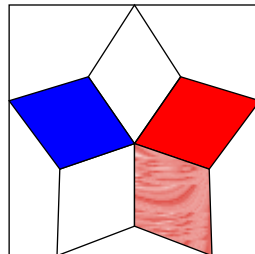
Run the Napkin holder front and back in the same way.

## Border pieces:

Hoop your stabilizer and run your placement stitches. Lay down top fabric and run the tack down stitches and the center design. Lay down your back fabric and run the tack down stitches. Trim fabric and run the satin stitches.

## Bottom and sides Napkin Holder: Hoop stabilizer.

run your lay down stitches. Lay down the front and back fabric. Run the tack down stitches then trim excess fabric front and back. Run the satin stitches to finish.



Depending on how large you want to make your runner will direct how many stars and border pieces you need.
