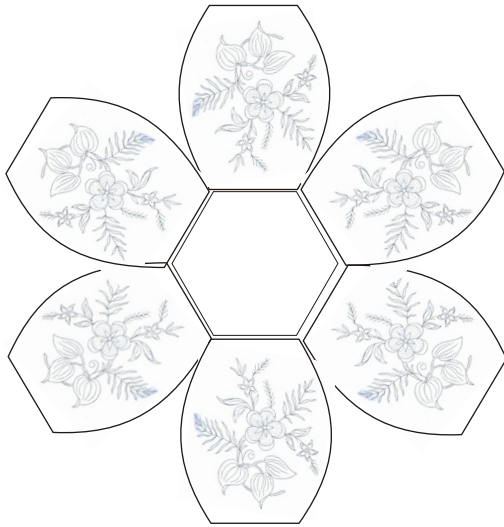


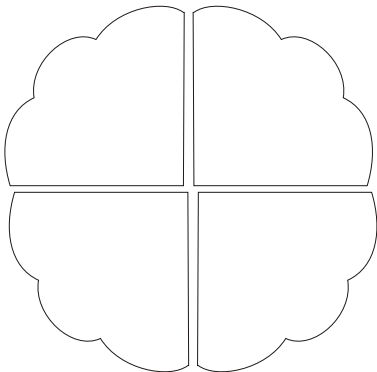
Applique Pumpkin Basket



Start with the side panels.
I hoop Badgemaster or Valeen
then run the first straight stitches
to indicate where the fabric should be placed
I then tape down the fabric to hold it while I
run the second set of straight stitches.
Remove the hoop from the machine but leave the
project hooped. Trim the fabric and return to the machine
Finish stitching the floral design on the panel.
Stop the machine and remove the hoop from the machine
on the back of your hoop tape down your inside fabric and
return to the machine. Run the straight stitches.
Stop the machine and remove the hoop from the machine.
Trim the fabric and then return the project to the machine.
Stitch out the satin stitches to finish the panel
The panels and bottom and lid are all stitched out this way.



Stitch the bottom to the side panels as shown.
From here start stitching the side panels together.
I start sewing from the bottom to the top working the
curve of the panel together slowly. Do this to each
panel.



Stitch the top panels together.
I sewed 2 panels together forming 2 halves
then sewed the 2 halves together.
You can embellish your top
with beads if you choose.
