

Snowman Kitchen set.



Center Design

Hoop your stabilizer I used 2.5oz Cut a way. Run the placement stitches, lay down the front fabric. Run the tack down stitches and the center design. Lay down the back fabric and run the tack down stitches. Trim front and back and run the satin stitches. Repeat with the process with the sides of the towel topper and the 4 inside panels of the hot pad.

Sides and Corners

Hoop the stabilizer and run the tack down stitches place the fabric front and back and run the tack down stitches. Trim then run the satin stitches.

Hot Pad Assembly

I stitch together using my sewing machine the 4 inside corners I used a wide zig zag stitch. Then I placed the snowman in the center and stitched it in. Next I sew the sides together 2 sides and a corner then attach to the hot pad as shown.

Towel topper.

I stitched together the sides of the topper, Front and back. Add the center to the front stitching these also with a wide zig zag stitch. There are 2 hanger pieces this is to ensure you have the proper length. You can use one or both.

I stitched them together. Lay the front and back together and center the hanger piece placing it in between the front and back, stitch together using either a straight stitch close to the satin stitches or a wide zig zag on top of the satin stitches. Start just above the rounded corner on one side and work your way to the other side and end just above the rounded corner. Leave the bottom open for the towel to go through.

You can use a button or the snowflake button included in the set.

To stitch the snowflake button use the side and corner instructions.
