

## Spring Checkbook Cover



Pockets:(need 2)

Hoop stabilizer, I use 2.5oz cut away.

Run the placement stitches. Now lay down your fabric right side up.

Run the tack down stitches. Trim

excess fabric and run to the end of design trim away excess stabilizer and set aside.

Back:

Hoop stabilizer, I use 2.5oz cut away.

Run the placement stitches. Now lay down your fabric right side up on the top and one piece of fabric on the bottom or back side of hoop..

Run the tack down stitches. Trim excess fabric, lay down one of the pockets match the bottom corners to line up the pocket. Run the end of design. Trim excess stabilizer



Top:

Hoop stabilizer and run the placement stitches. Lay down your top fabric and run the tack down stitches. Next run the Oval placement stitches. Lay down right side up your contrasting fabric. Run the tack down stitches then the dragonfly design. Trim the excess fabric and run the satin stitches. Lay down your back fabric and run the 1st tack down stitch. Lay down your pocket again match the bottom corners to help line up. Run the 2nd tack down stitch. Trim the excess fabric and run to the end.

Trim the excess stabilizer. To assemble on the sewing machine sew the center together with a zigzag stitch.
